



THE LOST AT YOUR SCHOOL

- Luke 19:10 KJV - 10 For the Son of man is come to seek and to save that which was lost.
- Luke 15:1-32 – Lost sheep, lost coin, lost son parables

LABORERS

- Matthew 9:36-38 KJV - 36 But when he saw the multitudes, he was moved with compassion on them, because they fainted, and were scattered abroad, as sheep having no shepherd. 37 Then saith he unto his disciples, The harvest truly [is] plenteous, but the labourers [are] few; 38 Pray ye therefore the Lord of the harvest, that he will send forth labourers into his harvest.
- Luke 10:2 KJV - 2 Therefore said he unto them, The harvest truly [is] great, but the labourers [are] few: pray ye therefore the Lord of the harvest, that he would send forth labourers into his harvest.

A LOVE FOR SOULS – COMPASSION

- Mark 6:34 KJV - 34 And Jesus, when he came out, saw much people, and was moved with compassion toward them, because they were as sheep not having a shepherd: and he began to teach them many things.

WISDOM

- Proverbs 11:30 KJV - 30 The fruit of the righteous [is] a tree of life; and he that winneth souls [is] wise.
- Matthew 10:16 KJV - 16 Behold, I send you forth as sheep in the midst of wolves: be ye therefore wise as serpents, and harmless as doves.
- James 1:5 KJV - 5 If any of you lack wisdom, let him ask of God, that giveth to all [men] liberally, and upbraideth not; and it shall be given him.

BOLDNESS

- Acts 4:13, 31 KJV - 13 Now when they saw the boldness of Peter and John, and perceived that they were unlearned and ignorant men, they marvelled; and they took knowledge of them, that they had been with Jesus. ... 31 And when they had prayed, the place was shaken where they were assembled together; and they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and they spake the word of God with boldness.

FOCUS ON PURPOSE

- 1 Timothy 4:13-15 KJV - 13 Till I come, give attendance to reading, to exhortation, to doctrine. 14 Neglect not the gift that is in thee, which was given thee by prophecy, with the laying on of the hands of the presbytery. 15 Meditate upon these things; give thyself wholly to them; that thy profiting may appear to all.
- John 9:4 KJV - 4 I must work the works of him that sent me, while it is day: the night cometh, when no man can work.
- 2 Timothy 2:4 KJV - 4 No man that warreth entangleth himself with the affairs of [this] life; that he may please him who hath chosen him to be a soldier.

THAT WE ARE SALT, LIGHT & EXAMPLES

- Matthew 5:13-16 KJV - 13 Ye are the salt of the earth: but if the salt have lost his savour, wherewith shall it be salted? it is thenceforth good for nothing, but to be cast out, and to be trodden under foot of men. 14 Ye are the light of the world. A city that is set on an hill cannot be hid. 15 Neither do men light a candle, and put it under a bushel, but on a candlestick; and it

giveth light unto all that are in the house. 16 Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven.

- Philippians 2:14-16 KJV - 14 Do all things without murmurings and disputings: 15 That ye may be blameless and harmless, the sons of God, without rebuke, in the midst of a crooked and perverse nation, among whom ye shine as lights in the world; 16 Holding forth the word of life; that I may rejoice in the day of Christ, that I have not run in vain, neither laboured in vain.
- 1 Timothy 4:12 KJV - 12 Let no man despise thy youth; but be thou an example of the believers, in word, in conversation, in charity, in spirit, in faith, in purity.

THAT GOD WOULD PRICK AND OPEN HEARTS

- Acts 2:37 KJV - 37 Now when they heard [this], they were pricked in their heart, and said unto Peter and to the rest of the apostles, Men [and] brethren, what shall we do?
- Acts 16:14 KJV - 14 And a certain woman named Lydia, a seller of purple, of the city of Thyatira, which worshipped God, heard [us]: whose heart the Lord opened, that she attended unto the things which were spoken of Paul.

THAT GOD WOULD SAVE

- Matthew 1:21 KJV - 21 And she shall bring forth a son, and thou shalt call his name JESUS: for he shall save his people from their sins.

THAT GOD WOULD SPEAK

- Isaiah 55:10-11 KJV - 10 For as the rain cometh down, and the snow from heaven, and returneth not thither, but watereth the earth, and maketh it bring forth and bud, that it may give seed to the sower, and bread to the eater: 11 So shall my word be that goeth forth out of my mouth: it shall not return unto me void, but it shall accomplish that which I please, and it shall prosper [in the thing] whereto I sent it.

THAT GOD WOULD MOVE

- Mark 16:20 KJV - 20 And they went forth, and preached every where, the Lord working with [them], and confirming the word with signs following. Amen.
- 1 Corinthians 2:4-5 KJV - 4 And my speech and my preaching [was] not with enticing words of man's wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of power: 5 That your faith should not stand in the wisdom of men, but in the power of God.

TEAM UNITY – ONE ACCORD

- Acts 2:1, 46-47 KJV - 1 And when the day of Pentecost was fully come, they were all with one accord in one place. ... 46 And they, continuing daily with one accord in the temple, and breaking bread from house to house, did eat their meat with gladness and singleness of heart, 47 Praising God, and having favour with all the people. And the Lord added to the church daily such as should be saved.
- 1 Corinthians 1:10 KJV - 10 Now I beseech you, brethren, by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that ye all speak the same thing, and [that] there be no divisions among you; but [that] ye be perfectly joined together in the same mind and in the same judgment.
